Empirical research articles (qualitative, quantitative and quali-quantitative)

It is an original research report that presents the sources of primary or secondary data. It should present a structure divided into several sections that reflect the stages of the investigation process, in the following order: introduction (development of the problem with a review of the empirical literature related to the problem and presentation of the justification for the investigation); method (description of participants/subjects, instruments, materials/equipment and procedures used to conduct the research); results (report of findings and analyses); and discussion (summary, interpretation and implications of the results that refer to the authors who founded the study).

This type of text must have between 20 and 25 pages, including summary, abstract, figures, tables, and references. An abstract and keywords must be presented in Portuguese, abstracts and keywords in English, French, Spanish and, optionally, in the author's mother tongue, each containing between 250 and 300 words.
